1. Introduction

1.1. These Terms and Conditions govern participation in the **UEFA Champions League Final Flash Campaign (“the Campaign”)**.

1.2. The Campaign is organised by Standard Bank Namibia Limited (**“the Bank”**).

1.3. Participation in this Campaign constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

2. Campaign Period

2.1. The Campaign will commence on **20 March 2026** and close on **30 April 2026**.

2.2. No activity outside of this period will be considered for qualification.

3. Eligibility Criteria

3.1. The Campaign is open to Standard Bank Namibia customers.

3.2. Participants must:

- Be Namibian citizens or legal residents
- Be 18 years or older
- Hold an active Standard Bank Namibia credit card
- Be in good standing with the Bank
- Not be affiliated with a Politically Exposed Person (PEP)

3.3. Failure to meet any of the above criteria will result in disqualification.

4. Campaign Mechanics

4.1. The Campaign is based on credit card usage during the Campaign period.

4.2. Participants will qualify for the draw based on the number of credit card transactions (**“swipes”**) made during the Campaign period.

4.3. Each qualifying transaction (swipe) increases the participant’s chances of being selected in the draw.

- The more swipes a participant makes, the higher their chances of winning.
- There is no minimum or maximum transaction value required for qualification.

4.4. Only valid and successful transactions will be considered.

4.5. Transactions must:

- Be processed and not declined or reversed
- Be linked to an active credit card account
- Reflect at least one financial transaction during the Campaign period

5. Winner Selection

5.1. The winner will be selected on **30 April 2026**.

5.2. All qualifying entries (**based on swipe activity**) will be entered into a random draw.

5.3. The Bank reserves the right to verify all qualifying transactions before confirming the winner.

5.4. The Bank’s decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

6. Prize Details

6.1. The winner will receive a double hospitality package to attend the **UEFA Champions League Final in Budapest, May 2026**.

6.2. The prize includes:

- Return international flights
- Accommodation
- Match ticket(s)
- One official excursion

6.3. The prize excludes:

- Local transport and transfers (**including bus fares**)
- Visa application costs (**unless otherwise specified**)
- Personal expenses and incidentals

7. Travel Requirements

7.1. The winner must:

- Hold a valid passport
- Be eligible to apply for a Schengen visa
- Be available to travel on the dates specified by the Bank

7.2. Failure to obtain a visa will result in forfeiture of the prize.

7.3. The Bank will not be responsible for visa denials or delays.

8. Partner / Guest Conditions

8.1. The winner may nominate one travel companion.

8.2. The companion must:

- Be 18 years or older
- Be eligible to apply for a Schengen visa
- Be available to travel on the dates specified by the Bank
- Not be affiliated with a Politically Exposed Person (PEP)

8.3. The companion is not required to be a customer of the Bank.

9. General Conditions

9.1. The prize is:

- Non-transferable
- Non-exchangeable
- Not redeemable for cash

9.2. The Bank reserves the right to:

- Substitute the prize with one of equal or greater value
- Amend or cancel the Campaign at its discretion

9.3. Any fraudulent activity or manipulation of transactions will lead to immediate disqualification.

10. Liability

10.1. The Bank shall not be liable for:

- Any injuries, harm, or medical conditions sustained by the winner or their nominated travel companion before, during, or after the travel or prize experience
- Travel disruptions, cancellations, or delays
- Visa-related outcomes

11. Data Protection

Participant information will be used strictly for Campaign administration and in accordance with applicable data protection laws in Namibia.

12. Brand Representation and Conduct

12.1. The winner and their nominated travel companion acknowledge that they may be required to act as brand representatives of Standard Bank Namibia Limited and Mastercard during the prize experience.

12.2. As brand representatives, they agree to:

- Uphold the values and reputation of both organisations
- Conduct themselves appropriately at all times
- Refrain from behaviour that may bring the organisation into disrepute

12.3. The winner may be required to:

- Participate in marketing and promotional activities
- Provide consent for the use of their name and likeness without additional compensation

12.4. Any misconduct or reputational risk may result in disqualification or forfeiture of the prize.

12.5. The Bank reserves the right to make a final determination on all matters relating to conduct.
